

Ordinance 639-21

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 300-06, SECTIONS 10.6 DUE DATES OF BILLS AND DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE, AND SECTION 11.6 DISCONNECT FEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Summerdale, Alabama as follows

The following Sections read:

10.6 DUE DATES OF BILLS AND DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Bills for water and sewer service shall be rendered monthly and shall be due on the first day of each month. Each monthly bill shall be the amount due plus any additional charges such as taxes and garbage pick-up for the preceding month. The bill shall become delinquent if not paid by the 10th day of each month thereafter and a delinquent fee shall be added to such bill. If any such bill plus the amount of delinquent charge shall not be paid by the 8:00am on the fourth Monday of each month a disconnect fee (non-payment fee) will be added to such bill and service may be discontinued to the customer. Before service shall be resumed to a customer whose service has been discontinued for non-payment of charges, the delinquent bill (and the amount of the delinquent charge) plus the disconnect fee (non-payment fee) provided for herein, must be paid. If service is not reestablished by the 10th of the following month after being disconnected for non-payment, the account will be finalized and the deposit will be applied to any outstanding charges.




10.6 DUE DATES OF BILLS AND DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

Bills for water and sewer service shall be rendered monthly and shall be due on the first day of each month. Each monthly bill shall be the amount due plus any additional charges such as taxes and garbage pick-up for the preceding month. **The bill shall become delinquent if not paid by the 15th day of each month thereafter and a delinquent fee shall be added to such bill.** If any such bill plus the amount of delinquent charge shall not be paid by the 8:00am on the fourth Monday of each month a disconnect fee (non-payment fee) will be added to such bill and service may be discontinued to the customer. Before service shall be resumed to a customer whose service has been discontinued for non-payment of charges, the delinquent bill (and the amount of the delinquent charge) plus the disconnect fee (non-payment fee) provided for herein, must be paid. If service is not reestablished by the 10th of the following month after being disconnected for non-payment, the account will be finalized and the deposit will be applied to any outstanding charges.
